Rally at Maryborough - October 2011

36th State Rally at Maryborough showground & Equestrian Park, Wednesday 12th to Wednesday 19th October 2011

Maryborough is a city located on the Mary River in South East Queensland, Australia, approximately 255 kilometres north of Brisbane. The city is serviced by the Bruce Highway, and has a population of approximately 28,000. It is closely tied to its neighbour city Hervey Bay which is approximately 30 kilometres (20 min) northeast. Together they form part of the area known as the Fraser Coast .

Bring sullage buckets for your caravan grey water. Grey water will be collected in wheelie bins and dumped into the dump point. Please **DO NOT** put rubbish in the grey water bins. It has been advised to bring a drill, if you are parked on the gravel area, it will be hard to get your pegs into the ground.

Ensure you have your receipt in hand upon arrival at the showgrounds.
