Action

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63rd Birthday Article

Mrs Mackie, a QCC founding member, wrote a report some 20 years after the club was first formed, of her recollections of the early years. On QCC's 63rd birthday, I thought I'd share with you some extracts from these wonderful recollections. "... in twenty years there have

been extraordinary changes in caravans and caravanning. The original members of the club and other early members were almost exclusively either (a) van manufacturers or (b) amateur van builders. Many interesting discussions could be heard at rallies as the advantages and disadvantages of certain cars, suspensions, (both car and van) couplings, braking systems, gear ratios etc. These opinions came in the main from people who had caravanned from as far back as the early thirties and these opinions were often backed up by the "bitter" experience of trial and error. How many people contemplating buying a caravan today would be over concerned (if at all) as to positioning of the caravan axle in relation to its length. The discussions that took place regarding a formula to establish axle position gradually crystallised to the most popular one i.e. ½" per foot of van length behind centre line (e.g. a 14' van would have its axle 7" behind centre)."

 I wonder how this formula stacks up today. These days we have a great deal more weight in our caravans and, of course, weight distribution is a major consideration.

To continue with Mrs Mackie's extracts ... "Alan Wright's van was completely burnt out whilst returning from a trip with Wal Tate so this prompted the club members to form a fire brigade, consisting of Alan Wright, Wal Tate, Don Mackie, Gordon Bowley, Frank Stainkey with volunteer hanger-ons to hinder them in their efforts. Oh yes they had a fire engine with all the necessary (and often unnecessary) equipment such as buckets, helmets, ropes, ladders, hoses, stirrup pumps, and even a water tank mounted on the truck, but only enough water to wet the onlookers."

Fast forward again to 2012 – I knew we had something missing from our emergency equipment – we need helmets! Doesn't Mrs Mackie's description give you a mental picture of lots of men running around falling over each other to put out a fire, with all the equipment – except no water?

The final Mrs Mackie's extract ... "The first rally of the club was held at Deception Bay on the King's Birthday weekend in June 1949 and was organised by Charlie Eaton who at that time was secretary for the Australian Automobile Association Magazine. Charlie Eaton was full of ideas and gimmicks to create publicity and he organised a "convoy" which assembled at the Chermside State School in Gympie Road opposite where Chesney Caravans Showrooms now stand. Police escort to Deception Bay was provided."

Fast forward again to 2012 – Where Chesney Caravans Showrooms now stand? Happy 63rd birthday.
