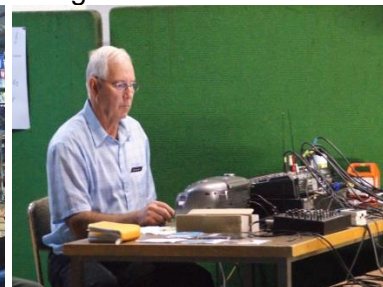

The programme was MC'd by Neil Chesney, cutting a real dash in his Dinner suit, filling in with the odd joke or two to keep the flow of the concert going.

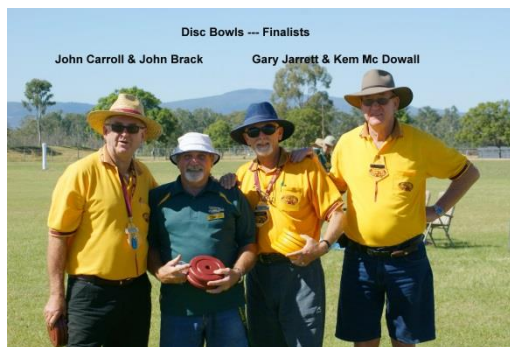
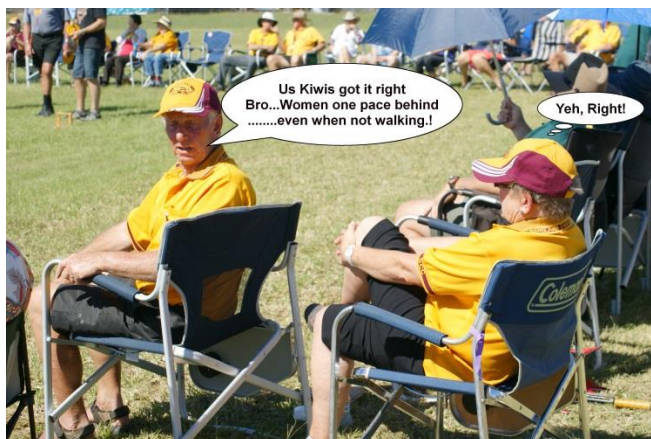
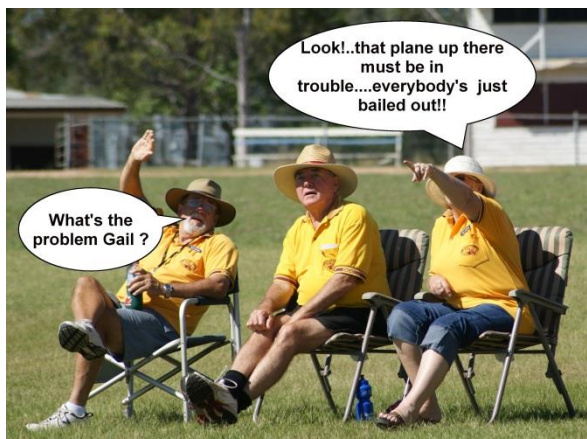

Many thanks to ALL the members who heated up and served the soup and laid out the dessert. Your efforts were well worth the results you achieved. It made for a great evening.

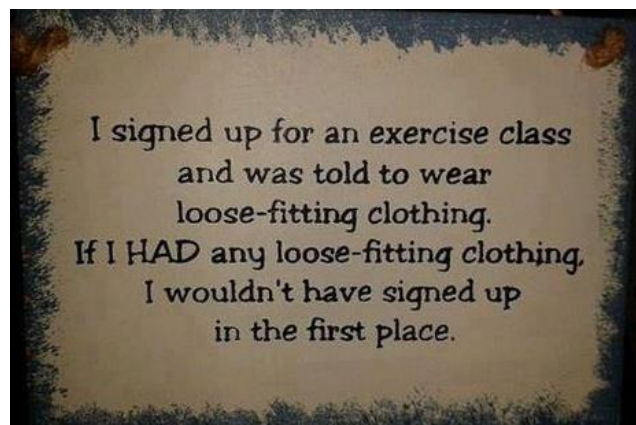
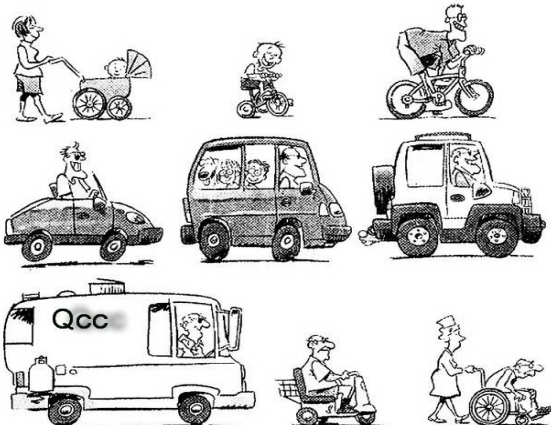
