Rally at Imbil Showground How to Get There

<p>Imbil Showgrounds (2/07)</p> <p>16 Edwards Street</p> <p>Imbil 4570</p>	<p>From Brisbane, travel north on the Bruce Hwy, past turnoffs to Caloundra, Ettomogah Pub, Nambour, Parklands, Yandina, Eumundi & Cooroy.</p> <p>Approx 20 kms north of Cooroy turnoff is the Imbil turnoff (on left), signed "Borumba Dam, Imbil". Turn <u>left</u> and follow this road (relatively narrow but 2 can pass easily most of the time) for approx 3 kms; then the road goes left over crest and winds downhill. At the bottom, the road goes right over a narrowish bridge. Continue for approx 1 km and then turn <u>right</u> into Tuchekeoi Rd (sign "Imbil"). Go over another bridge and continue until you come to a T-junction, where you turn <u>left</u> into Mary Valley Rd (sign "Imbil").</p> <p>Follow this road for approx 5kms. Turn <u>right</u> into Yabba Creek Rd (sign "Imbil"), then 100 metres turn <u>right</u> again at the Stop sign. Follow this road over a bridge and into the Imbil township, past the Island Reach Camping Resort on your right. Caution – there is a 40kph speed limit in Imbil. Turn <u>left</u> after high school into Edward St (sign "Showground"). Take care here, as after approx 200 metres school traffic could be turning. The showground is on the <u>right</u>.</p>

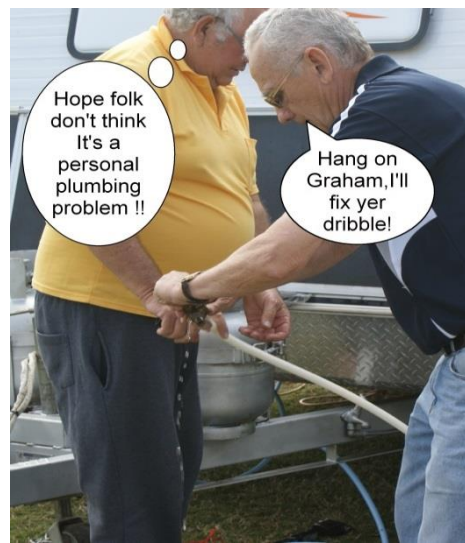

Friday was quite eventful on a day usually taken up by setting up and greeting friends. Most of what happened has been covered previously, but here are a few Pics concerning the goings on.



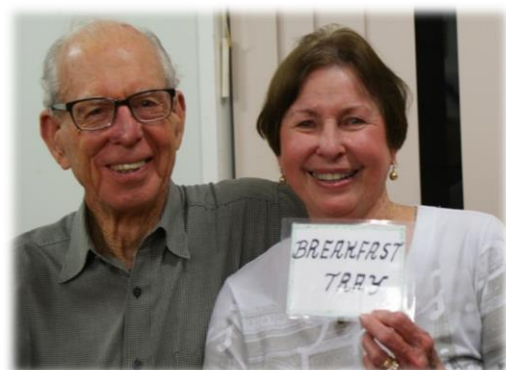

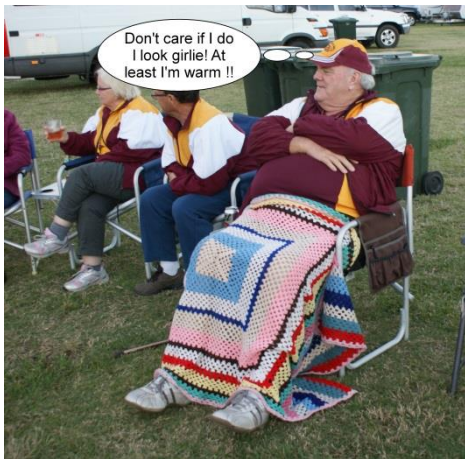

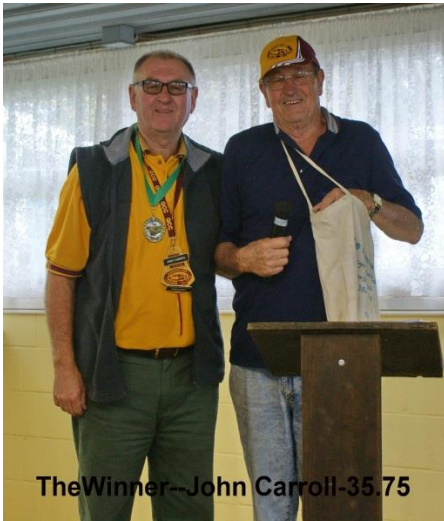
