At the top of the range, turn right into Dawne Street, and then immediately left into Margaret Street, passing Queens Park. At the end of Queens Park, turn right into Hume Street and then left at next traffic lights (Chalk Drive). Turn right into Ruthven Street (which becomes the New England Highway) and follow for approx. 43 kms to the outskirts of Crows Nest. The caravan park is on the left approx 1 km before town of Crows Nest.
	OR From Esk Follow Esk-Hampton Road to Hampton. Turn right and follow New England Highway for approx 11 kms to the outskirts of Crows Nest. The caravan park is on the left approx 1 km before town of Crows Nest.

Patrick and Ann Hetherman gave out the Prizes for the various categories in the Rally Comp.




