To date, the only item on the Agenda is the committee's draft for a few changes to the current By-Laws passed on the 14.12.2014.

I have attached a copy of the committee's Reason for Rewording some of these By-Laws. When or if the current draft By-Laws' document is passed with or without further change/s which replaces the current By-Laws dated 14.12.2014, I will forward this to all members.

The By-Laws' document for the club will always be an ongoing document for change as it reflect the Rules of the club and some of the necessary day to day aspects of club life.

Please peruse these changes in line with your copy of the By-Laws passed on the 14.12.2014. Please also advise if you have any concerns about these changes or indeed, if you wish to have a current draft copy of the By-Laws.

**Reasons for rewording the By-Laws that were adopted by the committee on 14.12.2014**

The previous committee, and indeed all past committees, have worked very hard in setting and/or reviewing the club's guidelines. The previous committee updated the Rules and By-Laws for the club and this committee sincerely thanks all who contributed in any way.

A few members had written to the previous committee concerning matters raised in the current By-Laws and as there was not enough time during that committee's year, these concerns were thought to be best addressed by the present committee.

In that light, the By-Laws have been reviewed and are now presented for the members' approval.

Reason for amending some current By-Laws:

- 3 To be counted as attendance at a rally  
(c) **This has been added**

This is to give clearer guidelines for the treasurer, particularly with the present database system.

**However the committee can grant attendance etc (This has been deleted).** Members passed at the General Meeting on 19<sup>th</sup> April 2014 at Woodford Showground that: “to be counted as attendance at a rally, a member must attend with a complying vehicle”. Members still have the right to lodge any complaint with the secretary and therefore the remainder of the paragraph is unchanged.

4. The word free has been omitted as it was felt not necessary. The addition of removal of pennants has been added.
5. This has been amended. As the secretary does not keep a register of qualifying vehicles. (a) Deleted. (a) (b) (c) (d) now reworded/added.
6. Membership. This was clearly a change from the club’s current system of addressing membership fees and other aspects of club life and a major concern for our club’s database.

The Rules of the club state that membership consists of an individual or an individual and the partner of that individual. The main reason for changing the basis for which membership fees are determined is that single membership appears to be inconsistent classes of membership outlined in the club Rules document.

**The wording now, is taken from the club Rules document** and hopefully give a clearer picture as to the classes of membership within the club. **Replaced annual fees based on per head basis with Membership fees to be set on a per membership basis. Members’ entitlement to vote wording amended.**

18. Members who have pets and dogs in particular, need a clear understanding of the guidelines within the club for their pet. The club allows pets and with both pet owners and non-pet owners working together, the rally site is a happy one.

It is hoped that the rewording of this particular By-Law becomes a little clearer for everyone.

19. This has been reworded as some members were not clear on what statutory requirements meant. In that light this By-Law was amended.
21. As committee meetings are now usually held after the end of a rally, it was felt that this By-Law need rewording; i.e. up to 7 days after a rally instead of prior to a committee meeting.

The Competition was intense, with some very close games .At the business end of the comp we had our 2 pairs of semi-finalists.



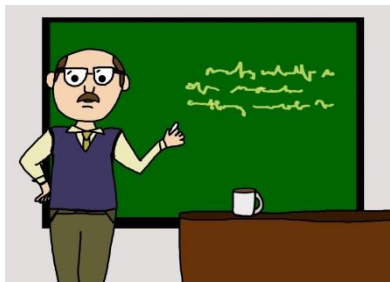

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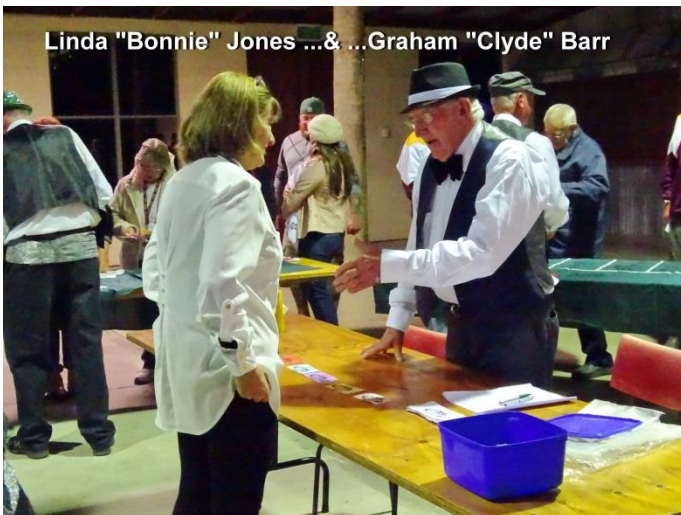
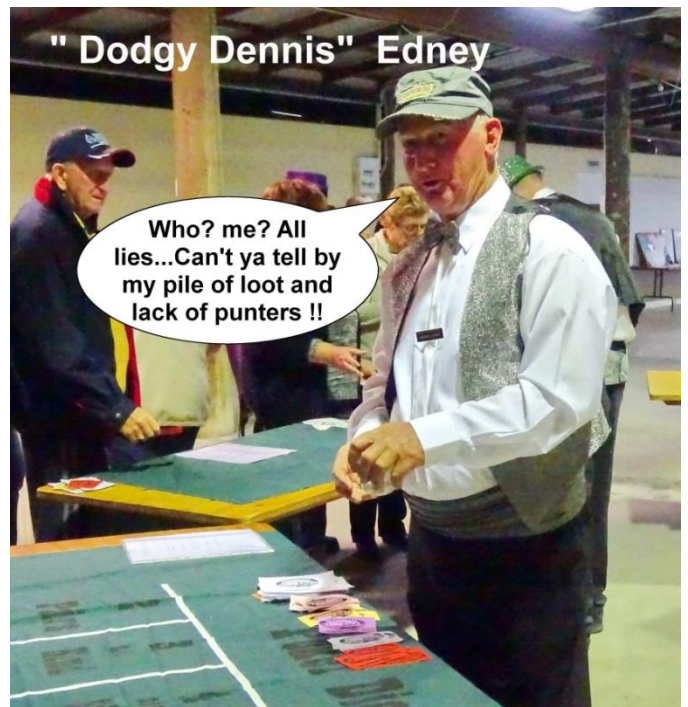
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Wonder what this chap did in real life !!
