Rally at Pine Rivers showground(Lawnton) How to Get There

Pine Rivers Showground (04/14)

From the south – Take the Gateway Motorway, continuing past the Depot Rd/Brackenridge and Redcliffe exits. After the Gateway Motorway veers left from the Redcliffe exit, take the next exit (signed "Brackenridge Rd/Strathpine"). At the end of the ramp, turn right into Brackenridge Rd. Continue along Brackenridge Rd. which becomes Hoyland St on a curve, then Strathpine Rd after it passes over Gympie Arterial Rd and eventually becomes Gympie Rd. Continue along Gympie Rd, past Westfield Shoppingtown (right). The showgrounds is on your right, shortly after you pass Bunnings and Supercheap (right). Turn into the showgrounds entrance and follow the club signs to the rally.

From Sunshine Coast – Travelling south on the Bruce Hwy, continue past Narangba/Boundary Rd exit. Take the next exit onto a service road (with different signs "Anzac Ave/Petrie/Redcliffe/Kallangur/North Lakes"), continuing past North Lakes Westfield. At the traffic lights, turn right onto Anzac Ave. Follow Anzac Ave to the roundabout, taking the 1st turn left into Gympie Rd. Shortly after the 2nd traffic lights (at Lawnton Pocket Rd), turn left into the showgrounds and follow the club signs to the rally.

For the benefit of anyone having to arrive on Saturday Morning, the Main entrance won't be available due to the markets being on. There is another entrance a couple of hundred metres further on which will entail going further on and doing a U turn to come back.



Friday seemed to be for maximum relaxation










A couple of "Meeting Musings"
