Rally at Hillview How to Get There

Hillview (checked 9/06)

From Brisbane, proceed along Beaudesert Rd, which becomes Mt Lindesay Hwy, continuing past Park Ridge, Jimboomba and Gleneagle, until you arrive in Beaudesert. (For people travelling from the Northside an alternative route is Gateway Bridge, Gateway MWY to M1, down to Daisy Hill turnoff, onto Loganlea road. Follow to Bris/Beenleigh Rd.Turn left then right and follow signs to Logan village and along Tambourine road to right turn onto Beenleigh-Beaudesert Rd. Turn left at Beaudesert Rd and follow instructions below

At Beaudesert, turn <u>right</u> at the main intersection in town (traffic lights) towards Rathdowney (still Mt Lindesay Hwy). Continue towards Rathdowney.

At Laravale (approximately 14 kms from the turn), <u>keep straight on</u> towards Hillview on Christmas Creek Rd.

Continue for approximately 17 kms – caution – the road narrows. At Hillview, veer left at the Y-junction. The Hillview Hall is right in front of you as you reach the Y-junction.

The Hillview Hall grounds entry is immediately on your right. Slow down as you prepare to enter the grounds **before** you reach the Hall.



Note: The QCC Secretary would have access to the club's NACC database and would list the above members' details.

CCQ would encourage all clubs to consider participating in the project. The main purpose of the Database is to be able to produce a Benefits Card for those members who register through their club. At present, the Benefits Card is limited to being able to access Ken Tame Insurance and discounts through Aspen Parks but further benefits are being sourced for members into the future. However, to be able to obtain such benefits, it is necessary for the NACC to be able to have figures to present to potential sponsors and this can only be done by Clubs using the Online Database. The NACC is only interested in aggregate numbers of members and is very aware of privacy concerns of club members. Therefore, strict guidelines have been put in place and members should not be concerned about their personal contact details being available to outside sources.

QCC Members will be advised by the QCC secretary when the NACC's QCC database has been implemented and is operational.
