Rally at Pittsworth showground How to Get There

Pittsworth Showgroun d (3/05)

From Brisbane, follow the Ipswich Motorway. Exit left (veering right over the motorway) onto the Warrego Hwy to Toowoomba (approx 95 kms to the top of the range). At the top of the range turn left (continuing on Warrego Hwy – Cohoe St) and very shortly turn right into James St (still Warrego Hwy). Continue the length of James St.

At Clifford Gardens shopping centre (on your right), turn left into Anzac Ave (Gore Hwy); the signpost says "Millmerran/Goondiwindi". Continue on Gore Hwy for approx 40 kms; turn left where the signpost directs you to Pittsworth.

As you enter Pittsworth, the high school is on your left, followed by a street and then the showgrounds. Entry is at the far end of the showgrounds.

Club News





On the Right is the only two handed thrower I have ever seen!


















The competition was very fierce and there was some very close games (have a look at this nest for the umpires to sort out, possibly 4?).


