Couple of items from Barbara Rutherford

NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF CARAVAN CLUBS DATABASE:

The QCC now has an online database through the NACC. The main purpose of the Database is to be able to produce a Benefits Card for those members who register. At present, the Benefits Card is limited to being able to access Ken Tame Insurance and Discovery Parks discounts but it is hoped that further benefits will be sourced for members in the future. However, to be able to obtain such benefits, it is necessary for the NACC to be able to have figures to present to potential sponsors and this can only be done by Clubs using the Online Database. The NACC is only interested in aggregate numbers of members and is very aware of privacy concerns of club members. Therefore, strict guidelines have been put in place and members should not be concerned about their personal contact details being available to outside sources. The only mandatory field that has to be entered into the database is your name and how you would like the card sent to you, i.e. by email or SMS to your smart phone. If you do not wish to give your email address, then it can be sent to the club's email address and printed out for you. I would encourage ALL members to come on board with this initiative – just let Secretary Brenda know and she will give you a form to fill in giving your permission for this to happen.
