Millmerran Village Caravan park. Proceed to Toowoomba and drive straight through on the Warrego Highway until Gore Highway / A39 turn on your left. Take the left onto A39 and follow all the way to Millmerran. As you come into Millmerran ,take 3rd street on your right(William Street),continue down to divided road (Walpole Street). Turn Left and drive down to next intersection and turn right onto Herbert street. Follow round to the left and cross the railway line into Attleigh Street. Drive down to intersection with Lola Ave then <u>bear</u> right, onto Lyndale Street. Drive to the end of Lyndale street, turn left and the caravan park entrance is on the right hand side in the white fence about 20 metres down.
