Make your way to Esk via Warrego highway, and Brisbane Valley Highway. On approaching Esk, lookout for left turn onto Hampton road, follow via Mount Jockey road and Perseverance Dam Road to New England Highway. Turn right and follow to Crows nest. Stay on the New England Highway for approx. 46 Klms from Crows Nest, where you will come to a bridge with "give way" signs on both sides of road. At the far end of this bridge turn left !! The turn has no signs, so be ready for it. The Showground is a few hundred metres up this road.(Cooyar—Rangemore Road).


