Rally at Laidley How to Get There

From Brisbane, follow the Ipswich Motorway. Before Ipswich, exit <u>left</u> (veering right back over the motorway) onto the Warrego Hwy (A2) in the direction of Toowoomba..

Continue on the Warrego Hwy to Plainlands. Turn <u>left</u> at Plainlands onto the Laidley-Plainlands Rd and travel 8 kms to Laidley, where it becomes Patrick St; continue through the main street of Laidley. In about 4 or 5 streets, turn right into McGregor st. Then turn left into Cooper street, then left into Hayes street.

PIN INTEREST

THE CASE OF THE TRAVELLING SEWING KM







It might have started out as an ordinary \$2-store spectacles case, but Sachiko Aldous has transformed it into an invaluable portable sewing kit. It's natty and neat and simple to do. Sachiko shows us how here: WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

C Eyeglass case

- C Fabric of your choice for outside and inside the case
- C Mod Podge
- O Sponge brush
- C Ribbon to hide the hinge area

HERE'S HOW:

Cut fabric for the inside and outside of the case. For the outer fabric, make sure that you

have enough to cover the whole thing and to tuck inside the case. For the inner fabric, cut the edges with pinking shears to prevent any fraying. 2and 2A. It's helpful to use a small dish to trace the curve and cut the corners. Also, fold the fabric horizontally in the middle and cut into it about 1in or so from both sides to make it easier to hold the fabric in around the hinges. 3 and 3A Spread the Mod Podge onto the case evenly and carefully place the fabric. Make sure there are no air bubbles. Then attach the inner

fabric in the same manner.

4 I pasted small ribbons around the hinged area to hide the ugly part that I couldn't get quite right. If you don't need it, you can skip this part of the project. 5 and 5A Make a small pincushion. All you need to do is measure the inside of the case and decide how big you want the pincushion to be. Don't forget to add an inch or so to the measurement; when you stuff it, the length and width will 'shrink' (because it gets puffy). Glue the pincushion inside the case. What you'll need.

1-Eyeglass case, 2-Fabric of your choice for internal and external covering, 3-Mod Podge, 4-Sponge brush, 5-Ribbon to hide hinge area, 6-Fabric glue or glue gun.


