CRAFT Remembrance Day



If members would like to make their own poppy for the Remembrance Day Service see pattern instructions below.

4 Petal Poppy Pattern

Using black yarn make a magic circle and crochet 12 dc into the ring, sl st to join. *1ch and 1dc in each chain, sl st to join. *Join in RED yarn. 1ch and 1dc in each ch space, sl st to join. *3ch, 2trb in same space as 3 ch, 3 dtrb in next chain, sl st in next ch (petal)*. Repeat this pattern from * to * 3 times - 4 petals.

SEWING AT NANANGO RALLY Owl Pin Cushion



Requirements 1 Fat quarter of main fabric (cotton) 1 piece of contrast fabric (cotton)10 inches by 6 inches 2 Buttons that stand out in colour against your fabric Stuffing Small piece of thick cardboard eg from a solid carton 3 inches (10cm)square Sewing thread to coordinate. Needle for hand sewing. Hot glue gun (this will be provided)
